2 Types of PRAISE Psalms

DECLARATIVE

Open exaltation of God; proclaiming the fact(s) that make Him great; expressing the blessings God bestows

DESCRIPTIVE

An *instructive* form of DECLARATIVE praise (invites & teaches others how to personally partake of the author's experience)

1 PET. 3:9-12 // 1 SAM. 21 // PS. 34

Psalm 34 Outline

Vv. 1-10: David's declarative praise to God

- <u>Vv. 1-3</u>: ...vowing to praise God and inviting others to join him
- <u>Vv. 4-7</u>: ...describing how God delivered him
- <u>Vv. 8-10</u>: ...calling upon others to trust in the LORD for protection and provision

Psalm 34 Outline

Vv. 11-22: David's descriptive praise to God

• <u>Vv. 11-12</u>: ...calling upon others to learn and

experience God's goodness

• <u>Vv. 13-22</u>: ...instructing others of how God delivered

him ("so do these same things!")

Types of PARELLELISMS in the Psalms

SYNONYMOUS

The rhyming of ideas rather than words; the thought expressed in the first part is repeated in the second part (with different words)

<u>Ps. 19:1:</u> "The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims His handiwork."

• (Ps. 2:4; 36:1, 2; 103:11, 12)

Types of PARELLELISMS in the Psalms

SYNTHETIC

The idea expressed in the first line is expanded/completed in the following line(s)

<u>Ps. 1:1-2:</u> "Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers;
(2)but his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on His law he meditates day and night."

• (Ps. 3:5-6; 18:8-10; Pr. 26:3)
