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Reflection & Discussion

2. Read and consider Jeremiah’s words of Lamentations 3:21-24:
 - a. What truths & qualities about God brought *hope* to his heart and mind?
 - b. What would your own ‘list of qualities’ about God look like?
 - c. (Extra credit: how do you define the word ‘hope’ from a biblical perspective? Why is *having hope* such a key aspect of successfully walking by faith?)
