- Requires profound respect and awe of God
- Begins with, and is maintained, through humility
- Brings PPOs (and PNOs to those who don't)
- Is the foundation of knowing truth
- Leads to long life, capacity for life, great joy
- Requires righteous choices & behavior

ANTITHETIC

The idea expressed in the second line is a stark contrast to what was expressed in the first line

<u>Ps. 34:10:</u> "The young lions suffer want and hunger; but those who seek the LORD lack no good thing."
