1 Pet. 4:12-19

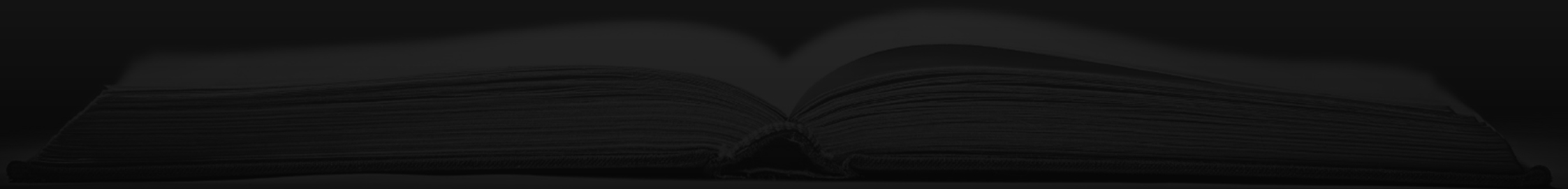


1 Corinthians 3:13-15 (ESV)
