The Believer's Call to REMEMBER

- 1:9: “...having forgotten that he has been cleansed...”
- 1:12: “...I intend to remind you of these qualities...”
- 1:13: “I think it right... to stir you up by way of reminder”
- 1:15: “...you may be able to recall these things”
- 3:1: “...I am stirring up your sincere mind by way of reminder”
- 3:8: “But do not forget...”
- 3:15: “And remember...”

2 Peter 1:11 (ESV)
