Reflection & Discussion

1. A key part of *false doctrine* is to diminish Jesus’ identity, denying that He is *fully* God and *fully* man.
 - a. What Scriptures make it clear of His *dual-nature*?
 - b. What arguments have you heard that deny His identity, and how do you respond?

2. Peter wrote his letters to a *subset* of believers: Jewish Christians.
 - a. In simple terms, how do you explain the phrase: “Not all Scripture is TO us, but all Scripture is FOR us”?
 - b. What other passages can be used as examples of this truth?

3. Read 2nd Peter 3:18 and have an open discussion regarding this key passage (What does it mean? How do I accomplish it? What things hinder me from growth? ...etc.)
