Some questions for Consideration

- 1. 1. God promised Israel, and He promised us, that when we walk in obedience to Him and His word, we will be victorious. In honest self assessment, how are you doing in your obedience to God and His word? Where do you need to improve? What, practical steps, can you take to do this?
- 2. 2. God's word is clear (1 Cor. 12) that we ALL have an important part in the body of Christ. We need each other to function as God intended. Are you an active and functioning member in the body of Christ? Or, are you "sitting on the sidelines" and not utilizing the gifts, talents and abilities God has given you for His glory and the benefit of His people?
- 3. What practical steps are you taking to protect yourself (family, friends, etc.) from the attacks and deception of the enemy? Are you being just a hearer of the word or are you a doer (walking in obedience, faith and righteousness)?
- 4. Take time this week to reflect on the faithfulness and provision of God. I encourage you to even write it down. As you think of other things, add them to your list. It will strengthen and encourage you as you see the Lord's faithfulness and promises fulfilled!
